Burns

PURPOSE:

Hot glue guns heat solid glue up to the point where it is molten and can be used to glue things together. When the glue returns to room temperature, the glue sets hard.



- Hot glue guns can reach 120°C and can cause burns if used incorrectly.
- Do not touch the hot nozzle or hot glue when working with your glue gun. Allow glue to cool completely to room temperature before touching.
- Do not leave your glue gun unattended when plugged in.
- When not using the gun, make sure to set it down upright on its metal stand, instead of lying on its side.
- Use scrap cardboard to protect the desks from glue spills.
- Allow to fully cool before putting it away.
